Interior (2009)

Here are some views from Alita's interior as it was when I took delivery.

Main cabin looking forward.

The "silver" post to the left is part of the lift mechanism for the centerboard. It's chrome-plated bronze but the chrome plating was in bad shape, so I had it stripped and painted it white. The head is just past the bulkhead on the left (port) with hanging lockers to starboard.



Main cabin looking aft. Galley sink above the engine compartment. Stove to the right (port) and ice box to starboard. The ice box was fitted with a cold plate; however, the compressor was found laying in the bilge. Evidently, the original engine was replaced but the compressor was never fitted to the new engine.
